8. GAME

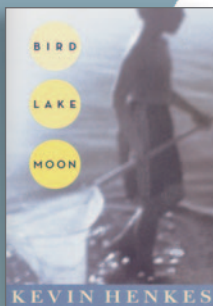

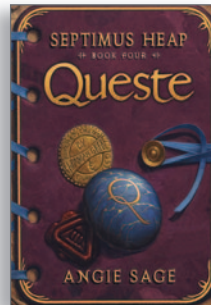

An Echo Falls Mystery

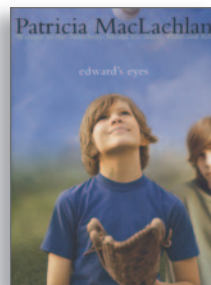
