by Joseph Delaney

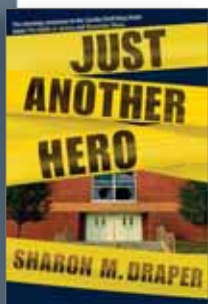

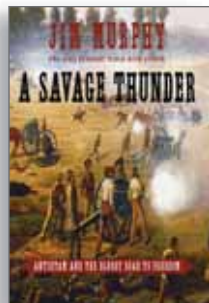

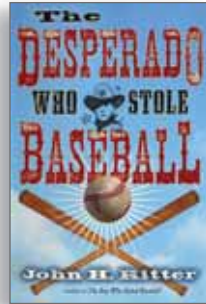
11. MOTHSTORM

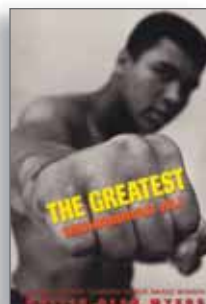


8. THE DESPERADO WHO STOLE BASEBALL
